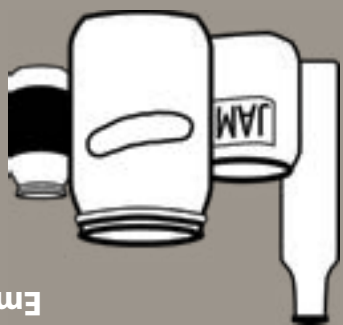

- Non-packaging glass like drinking glass, dishes, cookware, windows & ceramics
 - Lids

Clear and coloured non beverage glass
Empty & rinsed, labels ok

Glass & Bottles

- Not accepted:**
- Paper towel, napkins, tissues
 - Heavily food soiled cardboard
 - Non paper gift wrap
 - Wax coatings or foil linings
 - Books



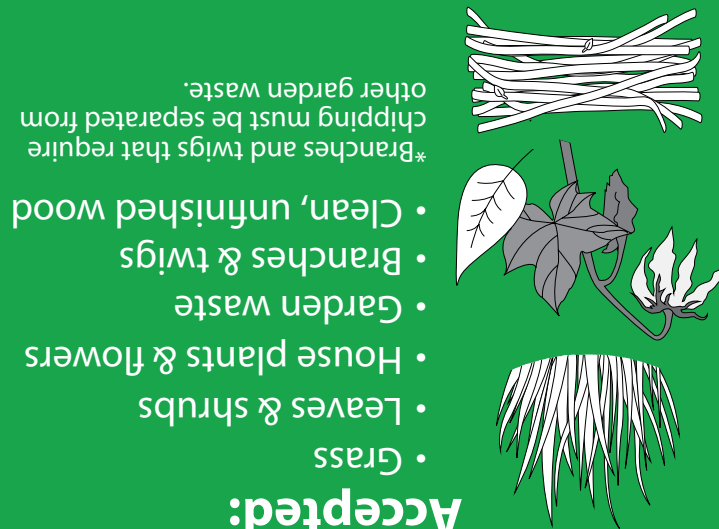
Accepted:
Empty & Flattened

- Not accepted:**
- Stand-up pouches or other flexible plastic
 - Biodegradable or compostable packaging
 - Propane tanks (dedicated area)
 - *Metal containers are collected separately at this facility.



Accepted:
Empty & Rinsed
Mixed Containers

- Not accepted:**
- Food waste, sod & soil
 - Treated wood, nails & glue
 - Pet waste & diapers
 - Brick, concrete & rock
 - Plastic of any kind
 - Invasive species

Wildlife

Access to waste (garbage, recycling and organics) is a leading cause of wildlife conflicts. Keep wildlife wild and your community safe:

- ✓ Store waste indoors or in bear-resistant containers. Truck canopies are not bear-resistant.
- ✓ Ensure recyclables are clean & stored indoors.
- ✓ Freeze smelly items in newspaper & rinse organic collection bins.

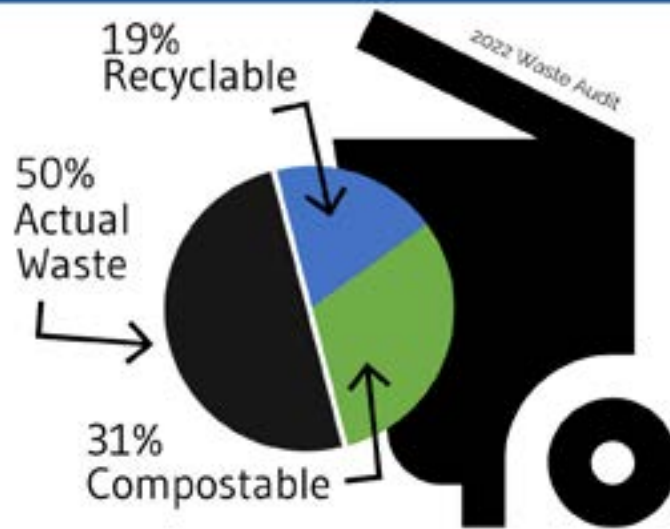


Leaving attractants accessible to wildlife is against SLRD bylaws & the BC Wildlife Act.

Zero in on Waste

Garbage to Landfill



Reduce costs by reducing waste.

Not accepted in garbage:

- Hazardous, flammable or biomedical waste
- Animal carcasses
- Automobile hulks and engines
- Waste that is on fire, smouldering or still hot.
- Asbestos & asbestos drywall (date stamped-pre-1990) *Disposal requires testing and approval. For more information visit www.slrd.bc.ca/LoveThisPlace/LLF

TIPPING FEES

Waste management fees are collected by taxes & tipping fees. Tipping fees ensure that those who generate the waste help to cover the disposal cost.

Other accepted Items

ITEM Free unless indicated

Antifreeze & antifreeze containers

Household hazardous waste (solvents, flammable liquids, gasoline, pesticides, fertilizers, corrosives, etc.)

Paints & paint cans

Used oil, oil containers & oil filters

Batteries (car, household & rechargeable batteries)

Electronics (computers, printers, etc.)

Cell phones

Light fixtures & bulbs (all types)

Small appliances (toaster, vacuum, etc.)

Large appliances (stove, A/C, fridge, etc.)

Power tools

Tires (bike, car & truck - less than 25" - fees may apply)

Smoke & carbon monoxide alarms

Effective January 1, 2023

Good news! More items are now accepted for recycling.

Your single-use and packaging-like products can now be recycled from home and the depot through Recycle BC's updated program.

✓ Paper

- Paper party decorations
- Paper gift bags
- Paper lunch bags
- Moving and storage boxes
- Paper gift boxes



✓ Flexible Plastics (Depot only)

- Sandwich and freezer bags
- Plastic reusable shopping bags
- Squishy cushion packaging
- Plastic wrap
- Plastic drop sheets or covering
- Plastic recycling bags



✓ Containers

- Aluminum foil trays and pie plates
- Plastic food storage containers
- Plastic and paper cups, plates, and bowls
- Disposable hangers
- Plastic plant pots
- Metal storage containers (e.g. for candy, etc.)
- Plastic utensils and straws



Reuse what you can.
Recycle what you can't.

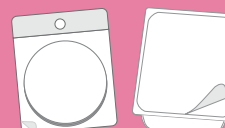

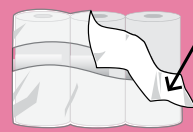

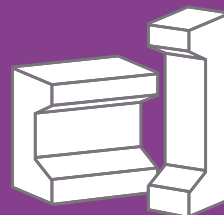
Not accepted:

- Plastic-lined paper or paper-lined plastic ●
- Biodegradable or compostable plastic ●
- Plastic squeeze tubes (e.g. tooth paste) ●
- Plastic strapping ●
- PVC or Vinyl ●

Accepted: Empty & Rinsed



Foam cushion packaging



Foam clamshells, cups and bowls for take out



Foam meat and produce tray

Not accepted:

- Foam packing chips, peanuts or noodles ●
- Liquid absorbing pads ●
- Blue or pink foam board insulation ●



Refundables Deposit Beverage Containers

Accepted:

Empty & rinsed, labels ok

- Aluminum cans
- Glass bottles
- Plastic bottles & jugs
- Gable tops, juice boxes & tetra packs
- Bag-in-a-box
